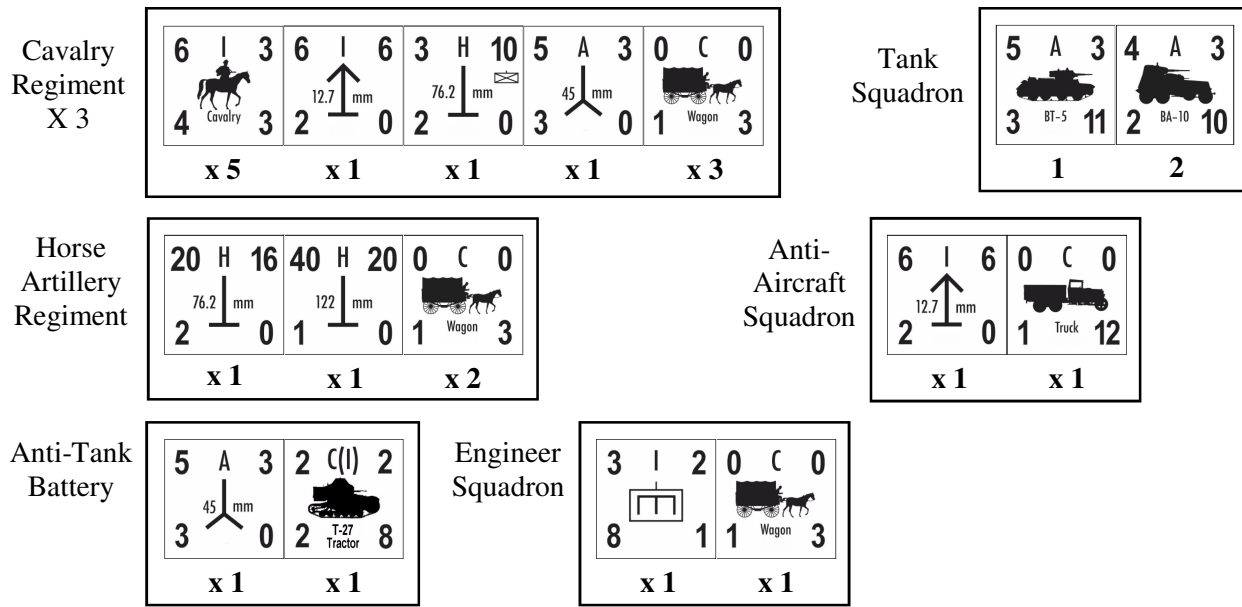


Russian Mountain Cavalry Division

June 22, 1941



On June 22, 1941, there were 4 Mountain Cavalry Divisions organized as follows:

17th Cavalry Division : 13, 45, 91, 128 Cav Rgts	7 Mech Rgt (2 T-26, 2 BA-10)
18th Cavalry Division : 46, 97, 135 Cav Rgts	33 Mech Rgt (1 BT-5, 2 BA-10)
20th Cavalry Division : 2, 103, 124 Cav Rgts	27 Mech Rgt (1 BT-5, 2 BA-10)
21st Cavalry Division : 17, 67, 112 Cav Rgts	23 Mech Rgt (1 BT-5, 2 BA-10)

4th Cavalry Corps : 18th, 20th and 21st Divisions, Interior near Moscow

The 17th Division was independent.

Three more of these little Cavalry Divisions were formed in the summer. All were destroyed by the end of the year except the 39th, which stayed in the Central Asia District.
